Ryman Healthcare Regatta

OYC hosted a hugely successful regatta last weekend at their home venue, Orakei Basin. A total of 21 boats contested the Fleet Racing (Line and Handicap Honours) on Saturday and 18 boats entered the Match Racing on Sunday.

Entries were received from far and wide with 4 contestants from the Cook Islands, 2 from Mangawhai, 3 from Mahurangi, 1 from Papamoa with the balance from local Auckland clubs.

Tricky light and fickle conditions greeted the sailors on Saturday at the start of the **fleet racing** with a few races being shortened due to the time lapse regulations. However, the wind did fill in on occasions to allow the full complement of fleet races. The sailors were split into three fleets of 7, giving a maximum of 14 boats in each race and allowing every contestant to complete 12 races.

Match Racing – Sunday

Better wind conditions on Sunday allowed for a full compliment of 72 individual heat races. Split into 2 flights of 9 boats each, meant every sailor contested 8 match races before the top 2 in each flight raced off against the top two from the other flight.

In the match racing event Greg was consigned to officiating duties so did not sail, however this did not deter the quality and intensity of one-on-one match race sailing. After around 3 hours of battling, in the Red flight, **John Rountree** with seven wins, topped the field on countback from **John Macauley** and in the Blue flight, **Paul Murray**, with 8 wins, pipped **Bruce Watson**, 7 wins.

Both semi-finals were extremely close with **John Macauley** coming from behind to beat **Paul Murray** and **John Rountree** just getting in ahead of **Brue Watson**.

An enthralling final series of close tactical racing saw Papamoa visitor **John Rountree (70)**, secure victory over OYC stalwart **John Macauly** (52) in a tense 3 to 2 victory.

John R commented " the match racing was very well run event and having Greg sitting there recording results and monitoring the starts made it run really smoothly"

A large group of Electron watchers were treated to several high intensity manoeuvres, learning a lot about the rules from our two extremely qualified judges, who kept everyone informed of the reasoning behind their calls.


