- 2. VENUE: Orakei Basin, Orakei, Auckland
- 3. RACING START: 09:00 hrs

4. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The "Ryman Health Electron Open Regatta" is organised and conducted by the Orakei Yacht Club

5. RULES

The regatta will be governed by The Electron Class Rules as adopted by the Orakei Yacht Club.

The Sailing Instructions shall prevail in the event of conflict with this Notice of Race.

6. ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to all unmodified Electron Class boats.

Controllers must be TE2R Futaba, T2HR Futaba, Flysky i6 Controllers and any earlier AM models provided by Des Townson. No other digital controllers are authorised. Any controller frequency clash will be solved on the day.

All boats must have a current sail number on their mainsails and have an allocated Number on both sides of their Jib. These must be vinyl.

Only sails as supplied by the Builder shall be used.

Skippers / competitors, must be members and/or regular participants, of a recognised Electron group.

7. FORMAT of Competition

Match Racing

It is the intention of the organising committee to hold the **Ryman Health Electron Open Match Racing** event, on Sunday the 12th November 2023, starting at 9:00 am

Match Racing Format:

Subject to conditions/time available, the Match Racing will be a round robin format, followed by a Knockout of Quarters, Semis and Finals, for the 8 top scoring competitors.

The highest placed skipper will race the lowest placed skipper etc.

The winner of each match-up will be the first boat to score two points.

8. REGISTRATION

Boats, sails and controllers must be presented for registration before **08:30** on the day of competition. No boat will be eligible to race until it has completed this process.

All boats must be as supplied by the builder.

All yachts are to be available for inspection at any time.

9. FREQUENCIES

Each competitor shall nominate their frequencies with their entry. If not using a digital controller, a listing of additional frequencies if available would be helpful. If using an authorised digital controller, please specify on the entry form.

11. PROTESTS

All races may be umpired. Anyone called for a penalty is required to do their penalty, under the match racing rules.

12. ENTRIES
